1 MR. TROMBADORE: I'd like to inquire of staff as  
2 to whether we have heard from Mr. Irek?

3 MS. HILL: No, we have not. We made notice by  
4 publication to Mr. Irek in the New Jersey Law Journal and in  
5 the Neptune, whatever - - Asbury Park Press. And we had not  
6 heard from him.

7 We then were advised that he might be in North  
8 Carolina and we forwarded the package to the address that we  
9 were given in Raleigh, North Carolina. And then that mail  
10 came back as forwarding time expired. And we mail - -  
11 remailed to another address in Raleigh, North Carolina.  
12 That has not been returned.

13 MR. TROMBADORE: All right, Mr. Gaughran, we - -

14 MS. HILL: But we have not heard anything.

15 MR. TROMBADORE: Thank you, Ms. Hill. Mr.  
16 Gaughran, we've had the benefit of - - of the - - the  
17 material submitted, and for record from below, what do you  
18 want to tell this Board that is not already in those papers?

19 MR. GAUGHRAN: I really don't think there's  
20 anything else that I can tell the Board, other than that  
21 early on in the investigation I personally spent countless  
22 hours in an attempt to try to locate Mr. Irek. But in terms  
23 of the hearing and - - I've nothing further to add other  
24 than the - - the two violations from the hearing panel 1.15b  
25 as far as the safekeeping, and 8.43 - - 8.43c, I feel

1 that there are violations.

2 MR. TROMBADORE: All right. Are there questions  
3 of Mr. Gaughran by members of the Board? Apparently you've  
4 done your work well because everyone seems to be fully  
5 satisfied with the record and there are no questions. I'm  
6 sorry that - -

7 MS. SCHECKTER: Your Honor, I have a - - excuse  
8 me. I - -

9 MR. TROMBADORE: You do have a question. Good,  
10 not to disappoint you.

11 MS. SCHECKTER: The only question I have is it  
12 possible that some harm has come to this man? Has - - has  
13 this been a consideration? That maybe it's not a willful  
14 disappearance.

15 MR. GAUGHRAN: I don't know. All I can say is  
16 that in my investigation he disappeared from Monmouth  
17 County, and the circumstances surrounding his disappearance  
18 I really can't say other than that from the - - the real  
19 estate development and the work that he was doing.

20 They were in economic shambles at the time that he  
21 disappeared.

22 MR. TROMBADORE: Mr. Gaughran, thank you very  
23 much. I appreciate your efforts on behalf of the system.  
24 Thank you.

25 MR. GAUGHRAN: Thank you.
