Dear Mr. Bossong,

I really hope that you can assist us in this matter as soon as possible. We are aware that Kenneth Irek is under investigation. The committee of ethics do not know of his whereabouts in order to contact him.

Kenneth Irek signed his check from us for the land he owned as Kirex Dev. Corp. and put it into his trust. Since he was an attorney we felt and our attorney felt that this was acceptable. We feel he was acting as his own attorney in handling the \$5,000.00 as the down payment. If you do not accept this as such we feel you are being unfair in re-viewing this matter. Because he is an attorney he is aware of what he was able to do and get away with it, by using the company name and not his own for the trust. We feel that Ken Irek knew exactly what he was doing and intentionally took our money and others without intent to give us something in return.

If we had felt threatened in any way that we would not have been protected of our monies held in his trust we would have asked him to have another attorney hold the \$5,000.00 in escrow.

We strongly feel that he acted as an attorney in this matter and feel that we should be compensated from the fund that was meant to protect people such as ourselves.
